Page 2 of 2 ENTRY CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

- 1. MACHINE PIECED BED QUILT, PROFESSIONALLY QUILTED: Pieced bed quilt (No applique). Professionally quilted is any person or business who is quilting for a fee. Quilt is longer than 72".
- 2. MACHINE PIECED BED QUILT, NON-PROFESSIONALLY QUILTED: Pieced bed quilt (No applique). Quilted on a Long Arm quilting machine by a nonprofessional quilter.
- 3. MACHING PIECDED BED QUILT, DOMESTIC MACHINE QUILTED: Pieced bed quilt (No applique). Quilted on your sit down home sewing machine.
- 4. HAND QUILTED BED QUILT: Hand quilted. Can be machine or hand pieced and/or applique.
- 5. HAND APPLIQUE QUILT, MACHINE QUILTED: Appliqued by hand and quilted by machine.
- 6. MACHINE APPLIQUED QUILT, MACHINE QUILTED: Appliqued by machine and quilted by machine.
- 7. MIXED TECHNIQUES QUILT, 2 OR MORE TECHNIQUES USED: Two or more techniques, excluding the quilting. For example, pieced and appliqued.
- 8. SPECIALTY QUILT- ART, EMBELLISHED, EMBROIDERY, ETC.: Any quilt with beads, painting, thread art, collage, etc.
- 9. LAP QUILTS-NO SIDE LONGER THAN 72": Lap quilt, no side longer than 72".
- 10. BABY/JUVENILE QUILT: Quilt made for a baby or child.
- 11. LARGE WALL HANGING-NO SIDE LONGER THAN 60". Quilt made to hang on the wall. No side longer than 60".
- 12. SMALL WALL HANGING NO SIDE LONGER THAN 40": Quilt made to hang on the wall. No side longer than 40".
- 13. MINIATURE QUILT REDUCED IN SCALE, NO SIDE LONGER THAN 24": Scaled down quilt pattern from a full-sized quilt pattern. No side longer than 24".
- 14. **GROUP QUILT MADE BY 3 OR MORE PEOPLE EXCLUDING QUILTING:** Bed quilt made by three or more individuals, excluding quilting.
- 15. OTHER QUILTED ITEM BAGS, PILLOWS, TABLE RUNNER, ETC: Items must be quilted; bags, clothing, placemats, pillows, etc.
- 16. SMALL WOOL ITEMS NO SIDE LONGER THAN 30": Small wool items, wall hangings, table mats, etc.
- 17. JUNIOR QUILT MADE BY ANYONE 16 YEARS OR UNDER: Quilt made by anyone 16 years old or younger.
- 18. PANEL QUILT ONE SOLID PANEL AND/OR CAN BE CUT UP: One solid panel or can be cut up to create the desired effect.
